With the company seeing demand in the air cargo segment, EVAS OEM VisionSafe has 3 other certifications for heavy transport aircraft due out this year. Flight Safety Foundation ranks smoke/fire emergencies as the 3^{rd} highest cause of fatalities. At least 1230 lives have been lost in air crashes where smoke and pilots inability to see their instruments was cited as the primary cause
