

Northwest Flight Makes Emergency Landing

Posted 9:53 a.m. July 06, 1997 -- Smoke seeping into the cockpit of a Northwest Airlines flight from Detroit to Milwaukee forced the pilot to make an emergency landing in Flint, Michigan Saturday afternoon.

None of the 48 passengers or any of the crew members were injured in the 3:30 p.m. incident, reports WCCO-Radio.

Patsy Drew of Northfield, Minn. was on the flight and she told WCCO-Radio that she "prayed a lot."

The airline made arrangements for all passengers to reach their destination.

The [Federal Aviation Administration \(FAA\)](#) said late Saturday a cause for the smoke hadn't yet been determined. Authorities continue to investigate.
